THE MARKS OF A TRUE BELIEVER A LOOK AT PAUL'S TESTIMONY --- PART 1 Philippians 3:4-11

- I. PAUL'S MINDSET BEFORE CHRIST: He had good earthly reason to be confident in the flesh (4-6)
 - A. Paul before coming to Christ, had far greater reason to rely on the flesh than the false teachers he was warning the Philippians about (4)
 - B. Paul's elaborates on his reasons for confidence in the flesh before coming to Christ (5-6)
 - 1. His **religious heritage** was great (5)
 - 2. He had reached the pinnacle **religiousness accomplishment** (5b)
 - 3. His **religious sincerity (zeal)** was unmatched (6)
 - 4. His **religious righteousness** was faultless (6)
- II. PAUL'S MINDSET AT CONVERSION: All he saw in the past as religious gain or profit was counted as loss or damage for the sake of Christ (7)
 - **A.** All previous religious gains were rightly reckoned as total loss (7a)
 - **B.** All because of Christ (7b)
