- A. **The Command for Leaders:** In contrast to speaking the good and profitable Word, Avoid, Steer clear of worthless unprofitable discussions and disputes (9a)
- B. **Their Characteristics:** Worthless issues that cause conflict (9b)
- C. **The Ultimate Reason to Steer Clear:** These things are of no spiritual benefit and are vain, worth nothing. (9b)

II. REJECT SINFULLY PERVERTED FACTIOUS MEN (10-11)

- A. The Command for Leaders: Reject factious men after two warnings (10)
- B. IS THIS MATT 18?
- C. The Reason for their Rejection: Knowing their true destructive nature (10-11)
 - 1. God commands it (10)
 - 2. Because of their true destructive, perverted nature (11)
 - a) They are factious (10)
 - b) God says if they do not respond to the warnings they are perverted (11)
 - c) God says if they do not respond to the warnings they are sinning (11)
 - d) Their own actions condemn them (11)
