WHAT ARE WE TO DO WHEN BLINDSIDED BY OUR OPPOSITION? THE BATTLE IS NOT OURS BUT THE LORD'S 2 CHRONICLES 20:1-30

- I. SEEK THE LORD THROUGH PRAYER AND HIS WORD: When confronted with an impossible situation, Jehoshaphat and Judah sought the Lord through humble dependent prayer, listened to His Word (1-17)
 - A. Seek the Lord's help in Humble Dependent Prayer (1-12)
 - 1) Acknowledge the situation in light of His power over the situation and His promises in relation to the situation (5-12a)
 - 2) Acknowledge your absolute inability to handle it and dependence upon Him (12b)
 - **B. Seek the Lord, listening to His Word:** Don't fear or be dismayed, the battle is not yours but the Lord's (13-17)
- II. RESPOND IN WORSHIP AND OBEDIENT TRUST: Jehoshaphat and Judah immediately praised and obeyed, trusting the Lord, worshiping Him and He routed their enemies (18-25)
 - A. Respond to His Word in Worship (18-19)
 - B. Respond to His Word in obedient trust and He will fight the battle (20-25)
 - a. Obey His Word, trusting in Him, believing what He said (20)
 - b. Obey His Word, trusting in Him, praising Him (21-22)
 - c. Obey His Word, trusting in Him, praising Him and He will fight the battle and He will bring victory (23-25)
- III. GIVE THE LORD ALL THE GLORY for the joyous victory and resulting peace (26-30)
