| I. | JESUS REVEALS HIS DIVINE AUTHORITY TO CONDEMN SINFUL BEHAVIOR: Jesus casts out the religious hypocrites, and then validates His righteous actions with His Word (12-13) |

| | A. Jesus authoritatively reproves the religious hypocrites who were using His temple for gain by casting them out (12) |
| | B. Jesus validates His reproof of the hypocrites with His Word, revealing their underlying wicked motives (13) |
| II. | JESUS DEMONSTRATES HIS DIVINE AUTHORITY BY COMPASSIONATELY HEALING THOSE WHO CAME TO HIM: Jesus did wonderful things, healing the blind and lame who came to Him in the temple (14) |
| W. | JESUS DEFENDS HIS AUTHORITY TO RECEIVE WORSHIP AS GOD: Jesus, through His Word, reproves the religious leaders who became indignant over the wonderful things He had done and the praise which was being attributed to Him (14-17) |
| | A. The religious leaders are angered by the wonderful things Jesus did and the rightful praise attributed to Him by the children and try to shut them up (15-16a) |
| | B. Jesus reproves them with His Word revealing He is God thus worthy of praise (16b) |
| | C. Jesus departs back to Bethany for the night (17) |
